- Insert the amount shown on your invoice in Question 15 (Requested Amount). The amount is not to exceed \$400.
- State "Specsavers [branch name]" in Question 16 (Please Nominate a Payee).
- Select cheque in Question 17 (Preferred Method of Payment).

If your application is approved, The Queen's Fund will arrange payment of the invoice direct with Specsavers and advise you by email once the invoice has been paid. This will be approximately 5 days after The Queen's Fund's monthly meeting.
